Triggering speech about 4 minutes in, after the scared village children tackle Moana's Father, one child says "I'm gonna t*u*!" and puffs his cheeks, but it doesn't escalate from there and the camera moves to young Moana.

Very mild scene about 13 minutes in. A villager mentions to Moana that Hei Hei "lacks the basic intelligence required for pretty much anything". Meanwhile Hei Hei is pecking at a rock. Moana says, "sometimes our strengths lie beneath the surface" and Hei Hei swallows the rock whole. She says "I'm sure there's more to Hei Hei than meets the eye" and Hei Hei then spits the rock back up. The rock comes out whole with nothing else and the audio is mostly clucking. He's fine and he continues to peck the rock.

Triggering speech about 56 minutes in, Moana and Maui make it to the top of a mountain and Moana looks off into the distance and says "the ocean chose you for a reason". Maui then sarcastically says, "if you start singing, I'm gonna t*u*".
